



SASI, a division of Zepf Center, is a Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) program for adults diagnosed with an Opiate Addiction.

WHAT IS MAT

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) helps normalize the body's neurological functions that have been impaired by the use of heroin or the misuse of prescription opiates. By reducing or eliminating the craving for opioid drugs and preventing the onset of withdrawal the medication provides an opportunity to effectively engage the individual in treatment. SASI is a comprehensive Opiate Treatment Program. Research has established the combination of medication and treatment is the most effective means of treating opiate addiction.

The Opioid Treatment Program is under the direction of the Medical Director and provides medication assisted treatment seven days a week. The philosophy of the program is to provide patient-centered treatment to persons who can benefit from MAT in order to obtain recovery and maintain abstinence.
