WHO WE SERVE

Zepf Center Youth Urgent Care provides timely access to pediatric mental health services for children and adolescents (age 6-17) presenting in a mental health crisis. The program is designed as an alternative treatment setting for those who need urgent (same day) intervention, but do not necessarily require the services of the emergency room.

TYPES OF SERVICES

- Level of care determination
- Clinical assessment
- Linkage to ongoing treatment
- Psychiatric Evaluation
- Benefits enrollment assistance
- Medication Management

PRESENTING SYMPTOMS

- Depression/anxiety
- Panic attacks
- Difficulty perceiving reality
- Changes in sleeping or eating habits
- Difficulties understanding or relating to other people
- Prolonged or strong feelings of irritability or anger

Services are covered for all counties in the Northwest Ohio Region, regardless of insurance or ability to pay.



BRING WITH YOU A VALID ID AND MEDICAID OR INSURANCE CARD.

Child's medical decision-maker must be present and, if they are not the biological mother or father, present proof of custody/guardianship must be shown. If this is not available at the start of the appointment, Zepf will be unable to prescribe any medications.
